

February 2020

FEB 1 | Thank God for the fruitful year of 2019 despite all the challenges. Pray that this year will be more rewarding as regards ministry work. May God grant us the virtue and resources both human and materials that will be needed to do His work.

FEB 2 | Pray that God will endure all the administrative staff with the wisdom and strength to carry out their respective duties to the glory of God and for the progress of the ministry.

FEB 3 | Pray for the families of the administrative staff, that God will keep them safe and sound in health and provide for them financially, so as not to be distracted in their duties. Pray for sound mind.

FEB 4 | The Board of Directors of TETMI will be having their first meeting for the year by the month of March . Pray that God will give them new insights into the work and help them to come up with better policies for the running of the ministry. Pray for their family spiritual growth, financial and medical.

FEB 5 | Several human development training will be coming up for the school teachers, missionary staff and administrative staff. This is to help them to harness the various gifts in them for the development of their various departments.

FEB 6 | We shall be embarking on a 10 day outreach to Obudu and kwande fields by the first quarter of the year. Pray for provisions for this outreach and volunteers to go with us and success of the outreach.

FEB 7 | The ministry shall be participating in several international and national Missions/Discipleship Consultation forum this year both in Abuja, Nigeria and Malaysia. Pray that it will be a resourceful event for her and a means to strengthen her work and discover new things God would want her to get involved in.

FEB 8 | The national Youth conference will be coming up by April. Pray that God will use this gathering to establish the Christian Youths in the fields more in their faith. Pray for all the resource persons that will be involved, that God will use them to actualize His purpose for the conference.

FEB 9 | There will be some Missions Awareness programmes coming up in different cities in Nigeria and foreign Missions deputation within the first quarter of the year. Pray that the cities of Portharcourt, Lagos and Owerri will be made ready for such.

FEB 10 | Pray that God will raise unto TETMI more missionary minded supporters and use them to encourage the ministry in all her endeavours. Pray that God will lead us to locate those whom He has directed to partner with us this year.

FEB 11 | Pray that God will use the TETMI Management Team to carry out fruitfully all the programme and activities billed for each department in order to grow. Pray for wisdom in all her deliberations and God's guidance and handling all the task and challenges before them.

FEB 12 | Pray for the President of TETMI, Rev Dr. David Umune, for Gods grace upon him as he leads the ministry to carryout God's divine mandate upon her. Pray for divine health upon him and family and pray against any distraction on him to forget the focus on the vision of the ministry.

FEB 13 | Pray that God will arouse the Board of Trustee of TETMI to action, so as to set the right principle and true monitoring of the ministry activities. Pray for the courage and boldness to stand up to their duties without fear.

FEB 14 | Pray for other bodies that TETMI is associated with, like NEMA, MANI. Ask God to use them as instrument to keep TETMI focused on her goals and show her better ways of carrying out the task.

FEB 15 | Pray for safety and protection on all travels as many travels will be embarked upon this year in our services for Christ through our Ministry and for the body of Christ in general.

FEB 16 | Pray for peaceful resolution of all the issues that are presently affecting our work on the field. Ask God for wisdom for all those involved in the discussions and negotiations.

FEB 17 | Pray for provision to meet our physical development needs at the field, completion of some structures, repairing and re-equipping of some. Pray for grace, wisdom and provisions to be able to implement the approved programmes and projects planned for the year.

FEB 18 | Pray for greater mastering of the techniques being taught through the leaders for programme, so that the participants will start making use of it and see results.

FEB 19 | Pray that two of our Primary Schools will receive government approval this year. All efforts needs to receive God's blessings and favour from government functionaries to make this successful.

MBASHOTO

The land is very idolatrous and people love to dwell in evil and iniquity, and thus are resisting the gospel.

FEB 20 | Pray that God will pour His Spirit upon the land, so that they may encounter Him, get convicted of their sins and turn to Christ. Pray against the gods of the land they worship and ask that God will put it to shame before their eyes. Pray for the missionary, Pastor Simon Abenga, that God will fill him with grace and power as he ministers amongst the people of Mbashotto and grant him victory over every spiritual challenges he may be facing.

AGENOGO

FEB 21 | Thank God for the discipleship programme going on among the believing youths. Pray that God will give them understanding and help them to grow unto Christian maturity.

FEB 22 | Pray for the missionary and his family, Pastor Chinaemerem Dike, as they face the challenge of also helping the community in relation to health matters. Pastor Chinaemerem's wife is already considering the option of enrolling into a nursing school, she can be trained to become more useful to God in the community and the environs.

FEB 23 | Pray also for provision of funds for the missionary work of building a missions' headquarters for the Kwande mission field. Ask God to touch believers and our mission partners to support this project.

TSEGUSE

Mr. Adum Anom was a juju priest but gave his life to Christ through the ministry of EMC in the land. Today, he is fellowshiping with the brethren. God also moved him to donate his land for the building of a place of worship.

FEB 24 | Thank God for the salvation of Mr. Anom and pray that God will put in him a hunger to know Him more and be used of Him. Pray for victory over the powers that will come back to fight him or make him to backslide.

FEB 25 | Pray for the seven persons who are currently undergoing discipleship training in the church. Ask that God will grant them understanding so that they may grow in Him and become instruments to reach out to the people of Tseguse using their mother tongue. Pray for the spiritual growth of other members of the body of Christ in the land.

FEB 26 | Pray for the missionary, Pastor Tervelnongo Simon, that God will fill him with His wisdom and power as he ministers amongst the people of Tseguse. Ask God for an outpouring of grace upon him that will enable him to excel in ministry.

AGBATSE

Orban Aluve was one of those who attacked the gospel in the land when the gospel came first to them. But today, the Lord has arrested him and he has turned to worship the same God he once attacked his followers, just like Saul of Tarsus.

FEB 27 | Thank God for the salvation of Mr. Orban and pray that God will cause him to grow in knowing Him. Pray for God's grace to come mightily upon him so that he would not go back but would pursue the furtherance of the gospel in his land and other neighbouring communities. Ask that he may be filled with the Holy Ghost so as to withstand all the wiles of the enemy.

FEB 28 | Thank God for His protection over the family of the missionary, Pastor John Abenga, against several spiritual attacks. Pray also that his family will be continually empowered to fight the battle to victory, quenching all the fiery darts of the enemy.

BECHEVE

A mission trip was carried out by the mobilisation director and his team to this village. During the trip, they carried out indoor crusade and revival, and follow-up training for some youths who could read out English using the English Bible. Part of their discovery was the lack of education and medical care for the community and its environs. The land, being surrounded by hills and at the other end by the Anile river, is caged out of communication and interaction with other communities. By this, most of the inhabitants are uneducated and very poor due to their inability to transact their farm products successfully with the outside world. Despite these, they are into diabolic lifestyle, bewitching one another. But thank God for the gospel which has brought some light to the land.

FEB 29 | Pray that God will visit this community in His own way and show them His salvation. Ask God to destroy all the powers of witchcraft and set the people free from its bondage.

March 2020

MAR 1 | Pray that the believers in the land will grow unto maturity so as to become instruments in God's hands to bring more souls to Christ. Ask God to fill the young ones under discipleship with the spirit of understanding.

MAR 2 | Pray that the move to get two of the believers - who could read English but stopped their education in Primary 6 - to continue their education will be a success. Likewise, two small boys were adopted to be given scholarships to finish their primary school education; ask God to strengthen them.

MAR 3 | Pray for the missionary, Pastor Chibuzor Onuoha, as he has been under serious spiritual attack due to his great work in the land. Ask God to give him all round victory, especially for the wife who has remained sick for the past 6 months now. Ask for God's power to be made manifest in him.

Becheve had a miniature health centre that was being managed by an elderly health officer who had a certificate in community health. This serves 3 different communities with the little it has been equipped to do. But tragedy happened when it was reported that the elderly health officer died. The communities mourned him as when a traditional ruler is being mourned. So much hope has been lost as regards the health care system of these areas. The first shock was the delivery of a pregnant woman during her labour. She was only attended to by some women around the village, seeing that there is no health officer to help them again. The child was born but the mother collapsed for about 5 days before God showed mercy and helped her to be resurrected through the prayers and effort of the missionary. Since this incident, so many who are having health challenges are in great dilemma as to what would become of them, likewise other pregnant women. This calls for great COMPASSION. Therefore, let us pray:

MAR 4 | That God will raise passionate mission-minded health personnel who will sacrifice part of their time to visit the village and render some volunteer service to them and through it share the love of Christ with them.

MAR 5 | A young lady by name, Stella, has been understudying the health officer and believes she can contribute to the basic health needs of the said communities. Pray that God will enable believers to respond to this great call. Ask that God will release His grace upon this young lady and make her capable of standing in the gap and to use the opportunity to show God's love to the people of Becheve.

MAR 6 | Ask God to cause the inhabitants of those communities to trust Him as the great Physician who is able to take care of them too. Let God's miraculous hands be made manifest now than ever before in their midst.

AKAEZEUKWU- EBONYI

MAR 7 | Thank God for the growth of this missionary station both spiritually and physically. Pray that God will sustain the growth and use them to reach out to other communities without the gospel, and also support other mission works.

MAR 8 | Ask God to continue to use the believers in the land to draw more souls to Himself, especially the men who are seriously engrossed in idol worship. Continue to ask God to pull down the power of Egbela festival in the land of Akaezeukwu.

MAR 9 | Pray for the missionary, Emmanuel Ezeoke and his family, ask God to fill them with wisdom and grace as the missionary takes the believers to higher grounds in knowing the Lord. Pray for divine provision for the family and sound health.

MPU- ANINRI LGA OF ENUGU STATE

MAR 10 | Pray that God will visit the youths of the land and cause them to surrender to Jesus Christ. Ask God to deliver them from the powers of fetish festivals that have taken much of their attention. Ask the Lord to pour His Spirit upon the land and its inhabitants.

MAR 11 | Pray for the missionary, John Ogbadu, that God will fill him with wisdom and strength even as he ministers amongst the Mpu people. Ask God to guide and direct him on how best present the gospel clearly to such an idolatrous community.

OGIRIEDDA, EBONYI

MAR 12 | Pray that God will strengthen the faith of believers in the land. Ask God to help them to stand strong even in the midst of adversity since after the destruction that befell them due to communal war. Ask God to bless the work of their hands and prosper them.

MAR 13 | Pray for the love of God to be shown amongst the believers in the land and also extended to the unbelievers. Ask God to reveal Himself in a way the people of Ogiri Edda will understand Him. Pray for grace, divine provision and protection upon the missionary, Pastor Sylvester Igwe, and his entire family.

AMAOSONTA, EDDA EBONYI

MAR 14 | The great miracle God has performed in this land has brought people to Christ. Thank God for it and pray for Bro. Agwu Chukwu and family, Serina Moses and all those who surrendered their lives to Christ; that they may grow strongly in their new found faith.

MAR 15 | Many believers in the land of Amosonta are facing challenges ranging from family to community challenges because of their faith in Christ. Ask God to give them breakthrough and the power to stand the tests.

MAR 16 | Pray for the missionary, Pastor Kalu Ukpai, that God will equip him the more so as to be a good instrument in His hands and fulfil his ministry in the land. Pray for his family also and ask for wisdom and strength to carry on the work; pray for their divine provision and protection.

BEBUABIE, OBUDU CROSS RIVER STATE

MAR 17 | Thank God for the growing faith of the believers in this community. Disciples are being raised from here and deployed to other communities with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Pray that such work will continue even as more Macedonian calls are coming up.

MAR 18 | Pray for the missionary, Pastor Oliver Igbe, who has had several spiritual attacks from the gods of the land due to the exploit of delivering men off their hands unto Christ. Pray that God's powerful hand will be mighty upon him and continually give him victory.

MAR 19 | Pray for the other churches planted by this group; Odigie and Kutiang, that God will help them to grow in the knowledge of Christ and use them to draw more souls to Christ. Ask that God through His Holy Spirit will empower these disciples to become great instruments in His hands.

UMUNKPOR IKEM NVOSI NGWA, ABIA STATE

The major challenge in this village still remains the vast number of youths who engage in cultism within the community. This seems to have overpowered their parents' control, but God would still have them come to Him to be saved. Therefore,

MAR 20 | Pray that God in His own way will arrest the youths of the land especially the leaders of the cult group and use them to reach out to others within the group in the village and other villages.

MAR 21 | Ask God to shake the foundation of the group and disarm them of every spiritual strength that have made them so powerful. Let the Almighty God deliver them from the hand of evil powers.

MAR 22 | Pray for grace upon the missionary in the land, Pastor Sunday Onyendi, so that he will be able to stand against all the whiles of the enemy in the land. Pray for increased wisdom and power to minister in the land; ask God to give him victory overpowers of darkness.

MAR 23 | Pray for partnership and unity amongst the few ministries in the land, so that they will form a strong front to fight the enemy and harvest the souls that God will bring to them. Pray for more spiritual growth for the believers in the land.

THE RUTH SUMMERVILLE CLINIC

The one week free medical outreach that took place at Ruth Summerville Clinic Akaeze brought many patients face to face with the medical doctors who attended to them and also gave a large number of them the opportunity to be exposed to the gospel through open preaching and spiritual counseling. Many of them were also requested to come back to continue their treatment with the regular doctor during the week.

MAR 24 | Pray that God will perfect the work that was done in their lives and reveal Himself to as many that heard His word and were prayed for. Pray for the expansion of the clinic and the necessary connections or partnership with NGOs, government agencies and International bodies who will assist in the provision of medications and services that will boost the image of the clinic.

MAR 25 | Pray that God will strengthen the hands of the staff of the clinic to become more committed to the task of rendering selfless service with the right sense of humor. Pray that God will keep revealing Himself to the staff too.

MAR 26 | Pray that God will make the patients who come to the clinic to receive adequate attention and be healed both physically and spiritually even as the word of God is preached to them every Wednesday and Thursday.

MAR 27 | Pray that the communities around will give attention to the issue of their health care, so as to take necessary steps in attending to their health on time; instead of waiting till the moment when the patient is almost dead before they come to the hospital.

EDUCATION | TETMI HIGH SCHOOL AKAEZE

There have been some outreaches that have taken place among the students and teachers of TETMI High School. God has used them to reach out to the institution and blessed them. It was both an academic and spiritual programme. This led to the strengthening of the faith of the teachers, and awakening the students to some realities facing them as pertaining to their environment and how to face their challenges.

MAR 28 | Pray that God will uphold the teachers of TETMI High School in their commitment and service to God and man. Pray that God will meet their various needs

and reveal Himself more to them and bless them for all their efforts in seeing to the growth of the school.

MAR 29 | Pray for the Principal, Deacon Akpu Uron, who has faced so much oppositions from the outside world because of his role in building the school. Ask God for supernatural strength and courage to face the task and gain victory over all his adversaries.

MAR 30 | Pray against any force that will want to rise to work against the school in any form; ask God to raise a standard against them and squash all their plans and frustrate their schemes. Pray that godliness will prevail amongst the staff and students of the school.

MAR 31 | Pray that the students will utilise the opportunity of the outreaches to get themselves prepared for higher grounds, both spiritually, socially and financially. Pray against any evil vices that may want to rise up amongst the students. Ask God to deal with them by exposing them.

APRIL 2020

APR 1 | Pray for increase in the intake of students and financial upliftment of their guardians so that they will be able to contribute in some ways to the education of their wards: the salaries of the staff of the school depend on this. Pray that God will provide scholarship for some of the students who are struggling to continue their education due to financial challenges on the part of their parents.

The chapel being run for the boarding students has been of great spiritual help to the students. The last time a girl who was demonically possessed was delivered after much prayers by the minister, Pastor Emmanuel Ezeoke. She was led to Christ after her recovery and today she is growing in the Lord.

APR 2 | Thank God for such salvation and pray that she will be rooted in Christ and not go back to the evil world. Pray for the infilling of the Holy Spirit to enable her walk in newness of life in Christ Jesus.

APR 3 | Pray that God will arrest any other student who is an agent of darkness in the school and protect other students from being initiated into their evil society.

APR 4 | Pray for the growth of the Scripture Union fellowship in the school and ask that God will continue to use it to build the faith of those who are being disciplined. Ask for wisdom amongst the student leaders of the fellowship and that of the entire school.

APR 5 | Pray that God will help the students to meet up with their academic requirements by causing them to be committed to their studies. May God increase their understanding as they go on with their studies.

NIGERIA.

APR 6 | Pray for believers that have been placed in strategic levels and positions of authority in the government of the nation. Pray that they have great wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of God. Let them understand who He has made them to be, and that they may have wisdom to make the right decisions and do things right.

APR 7 | Pray against demonic vibes, demonic influences that have led over the years to the creation of bad policies, killings, corruption etc. in Nigerian government. Ask God to bring these authorities and influences into subjection to sound judgement.

APR 8 | Take authority over every hindrances and oppositions to the gospel of Christ in Nigeria. Pray against every authority or influence that wants to prevent the gospel from growing on a fertile soil in the hearts of men. Rebuke authorities that harden hearts from receiving God's word, that steal God's word as soon as it is sown.

APR 9 | Pray for field missionaries and evangelists; those who take the gospel to the unreached parts of Nigeria. Pray that they will be greatly strengthened against oppositions and persecutions and be equipped for the work. Ask God for boldness and utterance to preach and teach in spite of their oppositions. Pray that they and their families will be greatly provided for as they go into villages and other places.

APR 10 | Pray that God will thwart all the counsels that are working towards the Islamisation agenda in Nigeria. Pray that God will defeat their plans and reverse their schemes to work against them.

APR 11 | Pray that God will visit the President of Nigeria, Gen. Mohammed Buhari and his team and bring His fear upon them, so that they may rule in godliness and reverence; knowing fully well that they are accountable to Him.

APR 12 | Democracy seem to be marred, the judiciary seem to have lost her integrity, security have been compromised, education seem to lose her value and economy has gone down the rail but our God is still God who rules over the affairs of men. Ask Him to come down and take over this country by Himself and sustain it by His power.

APR 13 | Pray against all the perpetrators of evil and wickedness in the country, especially the Boko haranm, Fulani herdsmen, secret cult activities and any other vices that engage in shedding of blood and causing suffering and hardship on people. Ask God to go after them, destroy all their activities and arrest all their members. May they encounter Christ like Saul did.

APR 14 | Pray for the protection of Christians in Nigeria especially those in the muslim dominated states and ask God to teach them how to still love their enemies in situations like this. Pray that they may keep growing in their faith even in the midst of the insurgencies. Ask God to give them the courage to stand and not deny their faith.

APR 15 | Pray for the believers in the South East and South Southern part of the country, that God will help them not to take light the evil intention of running them over with Islam. Ask God to make them awake to counter the Islamic strategy with the aggressive spread of the Gospel, even advancing and reaching out to the Muslims in their midst.

APR 16 | Thank God for the strategic efforts being made by some mission agencies in partnership with some denominations in Eastern Nigeria to reach out to these teeming immigrants who are Muslims and are relocating down to the East to reside. Pray for fruitfulness in all their endeavours.

APR 17 | Pray for other mission agencies working in Nigeria and beyond, like EMS of ECWA, Mission Frontiers, Baptist Convention, Calvary Ministries, Sons International, Gospel Bankers, Missions Supporters League, CMF, Kingdom Mission Outreach, Hausa Christian Foundation, USCWM, YWAM etc. Ask God to strengthen them and keep them all focused to their call.

APR 18 | Pray for the success of some of the national and international missions mobilizing conventions and leadership summits that will hold this year 2020, like the National Transformational Discipleship Summit, Lausanne African Congress, Leadership Foundation Summit, AFMA CONGRESS etc.

FOREIGN FIELDS

APR 19 | Pray for countries like Syria, Yemen, Somalia, Syria, South Sudan etc. who have been experiencing unrest due to internal crises. Ask that God will visit the fleeing civilians of whom many are yet to know Christ, and reveal Himself to them as the Prince of Peace.

EGYPT

APR 20 | The Coptic Christians still suffer heavy persecutions in their home land Egypt. However, the church has continued in demonstrating the love of Christ through openly professing forgiveness to the perpetrators. Ask God to use this action of godly love to draw many Muslims in Egypt to Christ.

APR 21 | EGYPT - Moroccan Arabs in Egypt

Pray for their spiritual awakening and for their eyes to be opened to the truth of the gospel. Pray for Moroccan Arabs in Egypt to step into God's kingdom in droves. Pray

for extreme boldness and love in the hearts of Arab believers, and for powerful encounters with the Holy Spirit. Pray for signs, wonders and miracles to break out and cause widespread wonder, which will lead many Moroccan Arabs to follow Christ no matter what the cost.

BANGLADESH

APR 22 | Almost 90 percent of Bangladeshis are Muslims. Gospel for Asia-supported missionaries must have a deep understanding of Islam and a persistent, dedicated faith in Christ if they are to be effective in this country. Ask God to give them great grace in this regard.

APR 23 | Because of its location between the foothills of the Himalayas to the north and the Bay of Bengal to the south, Bangladesh is prone to natural disasters. Monsoon flooding is almost an annual event. And storms, like Cyclone Aila in 2009, routinely make life miserable for the people of this country. Pray for GFA's Compassion Services teams who offer aid after these disasters strike. For many Bangladeshis, meeting these teams is their first contact with a Christian.

APR 24 | Bangladesh is bursting at the seams with more than 158 million people crammed within its borders – that is like having half the population of the United States all living in the state of Iowa. It is very difficult to purchase land, so many people live as squatters in one of the country's many slums, or try to pursue farming on flood-prone land. Pray that GFA-supported missionaries will be able to provide financial assistance through life-sustaining gifts from the Gospel for Asia Christmas Gift Catalog.

APR 25 | When Bangladeshis begin following Jesus, they know their lives will be a struggle. Some believers are kicked out of their villages. Others have seen their homes and churches burned down. They need our prayers to keep them safe, and to persevere in their newfound faith.

APR 26 | INDIA- Dhangar Bward People

How are the children of a nomadic people able to attend school? The Dhangar people have roamed the hills and forests of western India for hundreds of years searching for greenery and water for their animals. Most of the Dhangar children have been unable to attend school on a regular basis. As a result, many of the Dhangar people are illiterate. Due to their low caste status, their occupation and lack of education, the Dhangar are looked down upon.

APR 27 | Pray that the Dhangar people will begin to seek the true God and that He delivers them from their fears. Pray that the Dhangar people would receive the land their animals need and that their children may be able to attend school. Pray the Lord

will start a movement of Dhangar families experiencing God's blessings. Pray for workers to start a disciple-making movement among them.

NAVITHAN PEOPLE OF INDIA

APR 27 | The Navithan people are also called Ambattan or Muthuvar. Speaking Tamil, there are nearly 800,000 of them. Most of them dwell in villages in the southern tip of India. They participate in the yearly Hindu holidays. Hinduism is a major part of Navithan lives. They visit and pray in Hindu temples where they offer food, flowers, and incense to their gods. They also perform rituals to ward off evil spirits. All but a couple of the Navithans are thought to be Hindu; there are few known Christians among them, although there is a completed Scripture translation in their Tamil language.

APR 28 | Ask for God to establish thriving Bible-believing churches in the Navithan communities that will lead to a church planting movement in the 2020s. May they find their true worth in serving the King of kings!

APR 29 | Pray that the Navithan people will heed the warning of John the Baptist this decade, leading to a disciple-making movement.

PARTNERS WEEK

APR 30 | Thank God for those who have been a source of encouragement to God's work spearheaded by TETMI, pray that God will strengthen their hands so that they will not grow weary in well doing. Ask God to meet their needs as they take their time to address the prayer and financial needs of the ministry.

MAY 2020

MAY 1 | Pray for promotion in their place of work and prosperity in their businesses. Ask God to establish the work of their hands and bless them with sound health. Pray against anything that will become a distraction to fulfilling their role in the expansion of the kingdom of God through TETMI and other Christian bodies.

MAY 2 | Pray for their spiritual growth as they serve God. May they not become consumed with activities and start giving little attention to their personal devotion to God where they receive greater grace for greater exploits.

MAY 3 | Pray for their children and relatives who depend on them. Ask God to raise them up to the level of His operation in the lives of His servants. Ask God to grant unto them divine revelation of eternal things which will spring the children up to align with them in these kingdom investments.

MAY 4 | Ask God to open more the eyes and hearts of the partners to see the ripe fruits that are yet to be harvested and understand their strategic role in this great harvest. Pray for more hunger and passion to take over nations for God and that the life of sacrifice for the Kingdom be expose to them so that they may share in the wisdom of God.

MAY 5 | Ask God to make their challenges to become stepping stones for greater exploits in the kingdom of God. May they seek to pray from their heart: LORD LET THY WILL BE DONE. Pray that no rival throne will survive in their secret places but the throne of God.

MAY 6 | Bless the name of the Lord on their behalf, who has called them unto this holy calling. Prophecy unto their life, so that every dry bone and dry circumstances will receive life and turn around to become a mighty army; instrument in the hands of God.

MAY 7 | Thank God for your family and the grace he has given you to partake in His work through TETMI, pray that the zeal will not go down nor be distracted despite all the challenges around you.

MAY 8 | Pray for the prosperity of the work of your hand and ask God to reveal more of His heart beat for the Kingdom to you. Ask Him for more nations to take. Bless His holy name.

MAY 9 | Pray for the Owerri Missions Awareness that will be holding today, that God will draw His people whom He has given a burden concerning TETMI work to attend and likewise draw new partners for her.

MAY 10 | Thank God for the success of the International convention that held at TOKYO, JAPAN.

MAY 11 | Pray that it will spring forth a new and dynamic way of discipling the unreached nations.

MAY 12 | Pray that all the agencies that attended will not remain the same in the way to carry out the Great Commission.

MAY 13 | Pray that God will give them a fresh burden concerning the closed door countries of the World and the strategy to enter into them. Ask for God's grace.

MAY 14 | Pray for the forthcoming TETMI Staff discipleship training, that God will use it to mold the life of the staff to become more godly, making them ready for the harvest and rapture.

MAY 15 | Pray for the resources persons and every instrument to be used by God, that they may be ready vessel in God's hands .

MAY 16 | Pray for the World Synergy summit that will hold from 18th May 2020 at Malaysia, that it will be result oriented and that it will give a great boost to mission work among the unreached.

MAY 17 | Pray that TETMI will benefit from this synergy between Mission agencies and Missions supporting bodies and churches. Ask God for a clear direction of how this convention is to go, so as to become truly fruitful

MAY 18 | Pray that such synergy be multiplied across the World, so that in every country, Missions Supporting churches and Agencies will seek strong alliance with Sincere Missions Agencies. MAY 24 | Some of the missionaries reaching out to Muslims in the Eastern Nigeria, do complain of lack of cooperation from Eastern Churches. Hence it is making the work more difficult for them. Pray that God will break whatsoever Barrier that is restricting them from carrying out their mission effectively.

MAY 25 | Pray for better understanding amongst the church in Eastern Nigeria of their needed support and cooperation in this task. Pray that the denominational spirit be buried as the Kingdom expansion becomes priority.

MAY 26 | Pray that Christian Association of Nigeria will play a vital role in creating a healthy environment for the spread of the gospel. Let God turn them to become Kingdom based than being materialistic and political.

MAY 27 | Pray that God will raise Christian Businessmen who will commit their businesses totally for the furtherance of the gospel not just towards their denomination but across Christian bodies.

MAY 28 | Pray for the emerging generations, that God will raise from their midst men and women who will be sold out to the cause of the Gospel against the spirit of materialism and worldliness rampaging them.

MAY 29 | Pray that God will pour His Spirit upon the emerging generation and cause His Revival fire to caught up with them, so as to uphold the tenants of Christian faith,

MAY 30 | Pray that Campus ministries will become a great platform to raise tent making missionaries who will go across the borders with the Gospel.
